

Mystic River Greenways

The Mystic River Watershed is alive with community greenway and trail initiatives. Comprising a network of more than 80 miles of proposed and existing trails, it connects in all directions beyond the watershed boundaries to a growing regional network of long-distance trails including the Bay Circuit Trail, East Coast Greenway, and Mass Central Rail Trail. The Mystic Link will be the watershed's newest trail, a proposed 25-mile connection between the Bay Circuit and the Freedom Trail.
