Benches and good company

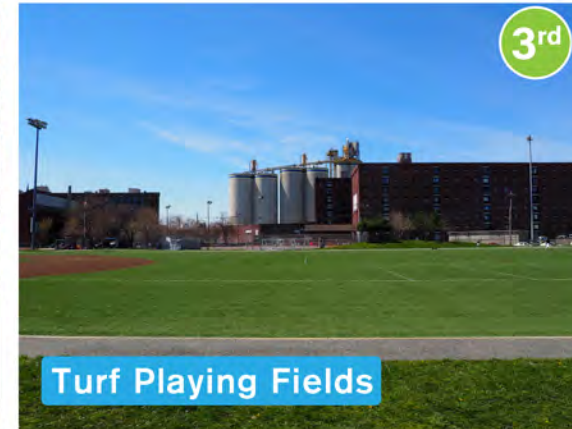

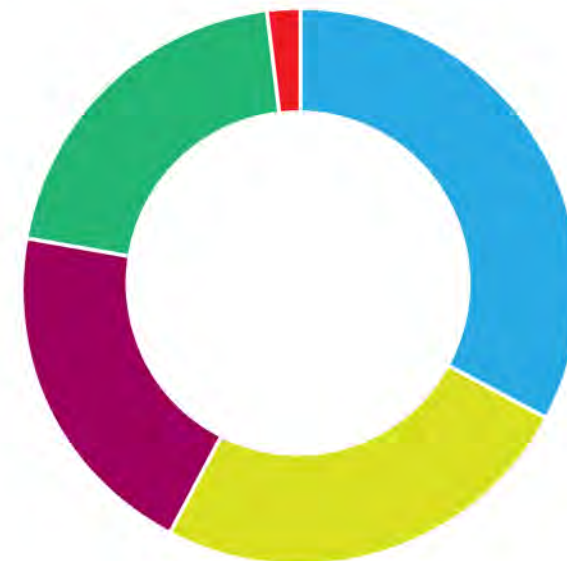


Has your time outside at parks increased or decreased during Covid-19 quarantine?

If you don't visit or don't like Little Mystic Channel, why not?



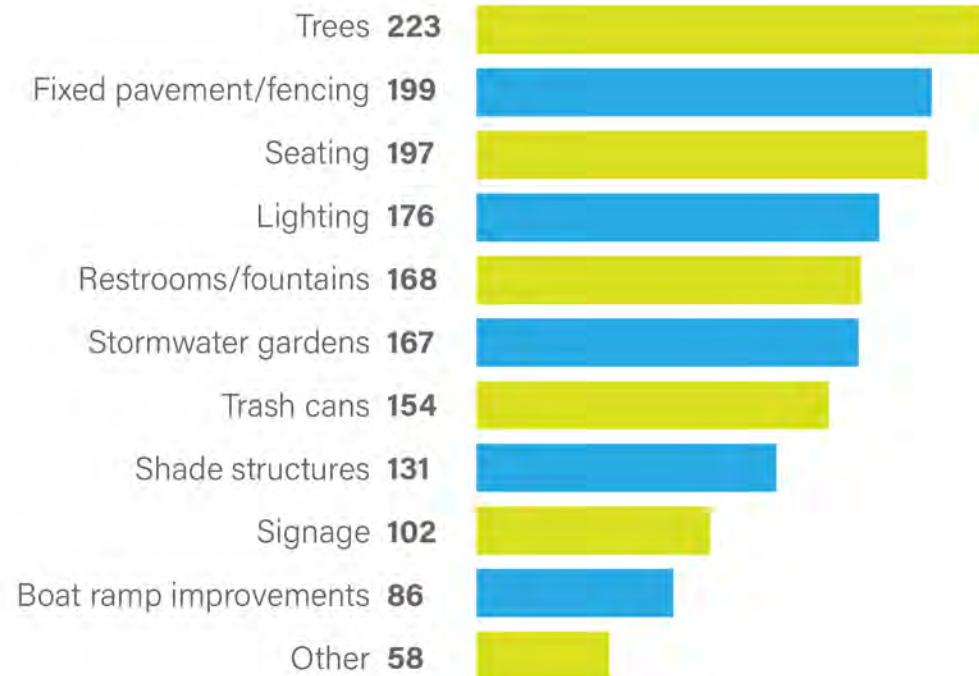
- Other (20%)

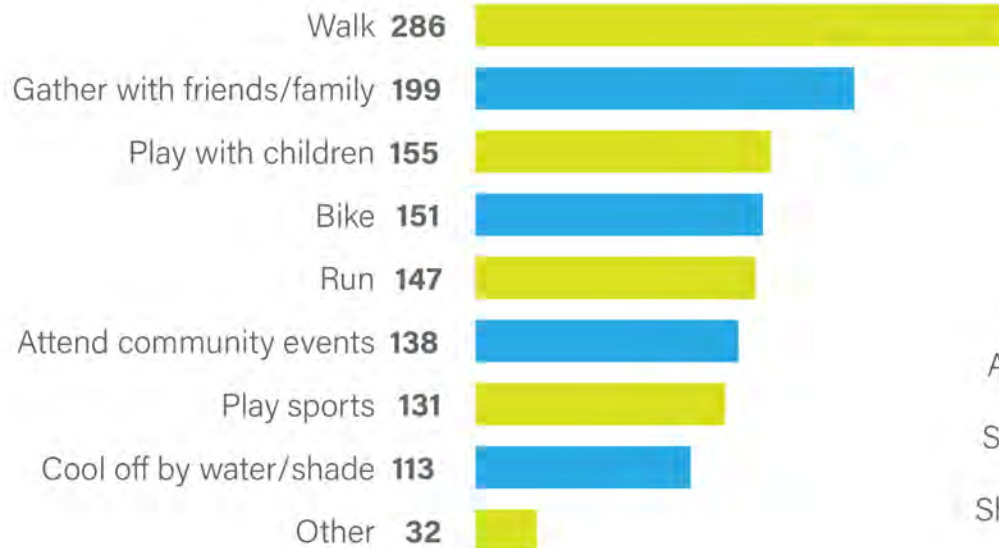

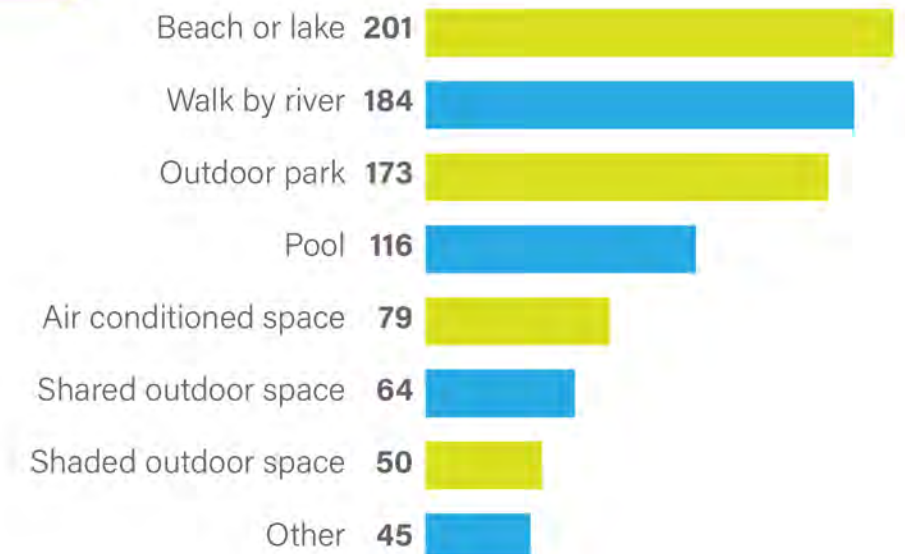
What kind of improvements would you want to see around Little Mystic Park?



What would you like to do around Little Mystic Channel?



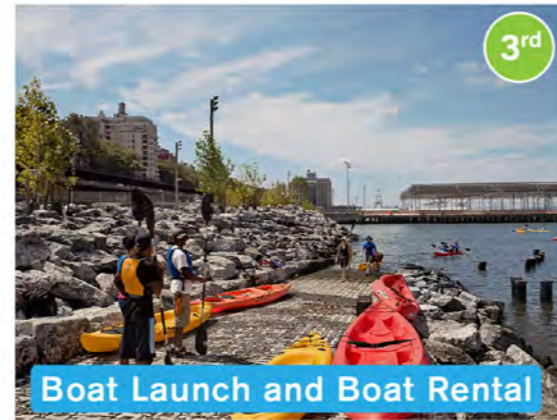
Where do you go to cool off in the summertime?

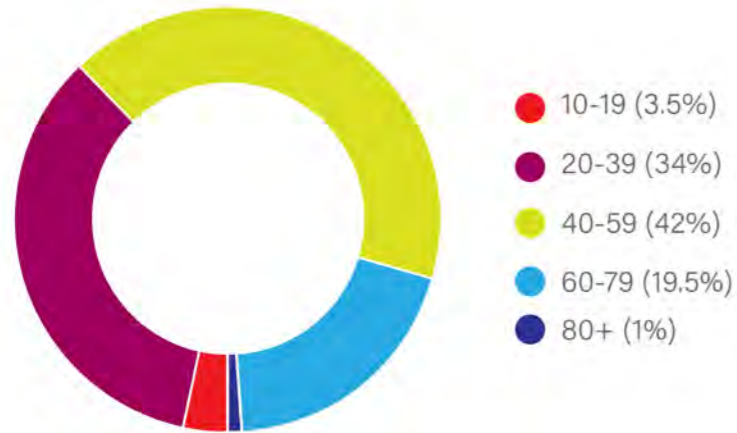

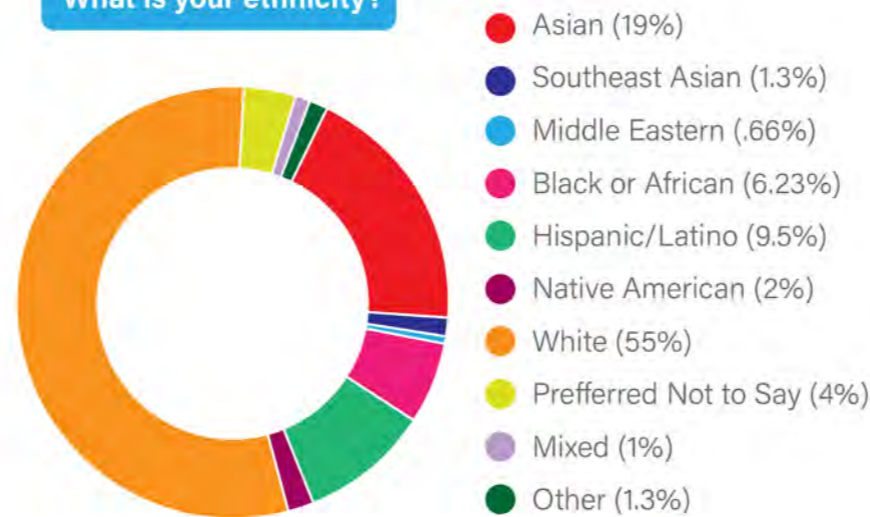

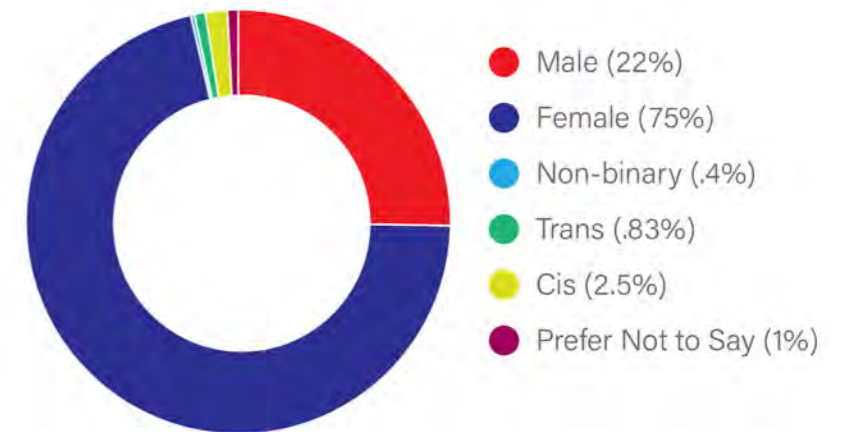
What is your age?



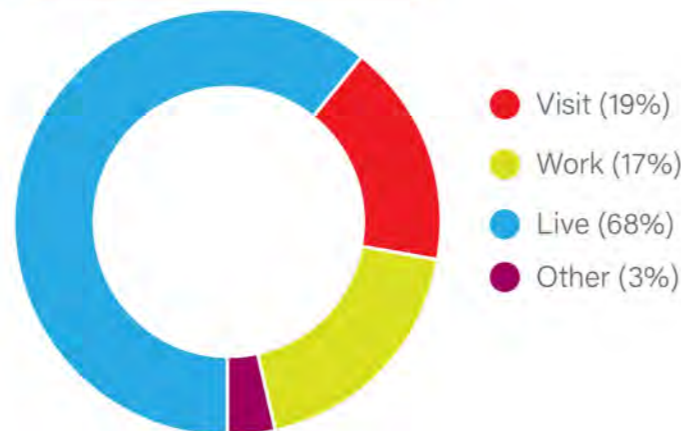
What is your ethnicity?
